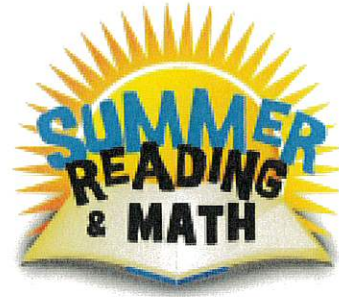


Incoming Grade 2 Summer Work 2026

This summer we will be using IXL as our tool to keep math and ELA skills sharp and try to avoid any summer slide.



IXL

1. Go to <https://www.ixl.com> (Log in with your child- use the information below)
 - a. Login with the information you received previously. If you lose your login you may email your child's teacher
2. Once logged in- hover over the learning tap and click skill plans
 - a. There you will see IXL Summer Boost: Math and IXL Summer Adventures (Some activities are only a trial since they are science and social studies but you can try them out anyways!)
 - b. Under each of these click 1st Grade
 - c. There you will find daily/weekly activities for your child to complete. Try to get a medal on each one!
3. There are many other things to do on IXL as well
 - a. Play games (Click learning - math - games)
 - b. Use the Diagnostic arena (Click Assessment - step into the Arena) (only available Monday through Friday)
 - c. Complete Recommended activities (Click My IXL - Recommendations)

Reading Log

1. Create your own reading log and keep track of all the books you read this summer!

We are requiring that all children read or have read at least 20 books or 5 chapter books (or a combination of the two) of their choosing. (50 pages is equivalent to 1 chapter book) Of course you may always complete more.

1. Log in to <https://www.kidsa-z.com/>
2. Type in teacher username kgoldberg14 or ajohnson1296
3. Click your name and enter your password, choose books to read and try to level up!
