The theme this year is "Color our World" and you can sign up online with the Baltimore County Library. Barnes and Noble Book Store also has a summer reading program. Keep track of books read and submit to the library according to their requirements.

Time spent reading with your child is time well spent, please take advantage of this precious time in your child's life as they emerge as avid readers!
