Rules are as follows:

- Students may answer questions as follows:
 - o Incoming 8th graders any skill that is 7th grade or above
- Skills that are repeated after they have been mastered (achieving a SmartScore of 100) once during the contest period will not be counted.
- No more than 50 questions answered by one student in a single skill (prior to reaching a score of 100) will be counted.
