

St Mark School Middle School Math Summer Work 2025

Incoming 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th grades:

Students should spend at least 60-90 minutes per week working on skills listed under their *MAP Skill Plan* on IXL. In addition, IXL is hosting the:

Students who answer at least 7,000 questions correctly will be entered in a drawing to win one of 10 prizes from IXL! (see *rules below*) All current St. Mark students have been entered into the contest.

Additionally, we will be running a weekly leaderboard by grade, and the top 3 students each week will win 3 house points to be awarded in RCA when we return in the fall. You may win more than one week!*(same rules apply)*

The IXL contest runs from June 9 to August 3, and IXL winners will be announced on the IXL Facebook page and the IXL Blog on August 12. The St. Mark leaderboards run the same time period, with an additional 2 weeks at the end. The leaderboards will begin on Monday morning at 9:00 and end on Sunday evening at 6:00 pm.

Rules are as follows:

- **Students may answer questions as follows:**
 - *Incoming 5th graders - any skill that is 4th grade or above*
 - *Incoming 6th graders - any skill that is 5th grade or above*
 - *Incoming 7th graders - any skill that is 6th grade or above*
 - *Incoming 8th graders - any skill that is 7th grade or above*

- *Skills that are repeated after they have been mastered (achieving a SmartScore of 100) once during the contest period will not be counted.*

- *No more than 50 questions answered by one student in a single skill (prior to reaching a score of 100) will be counted.*
